Section 4: Refusal. A.C.L.C. reserves the right to refuse membership to anyone. Membership is a privilege not a right.

When the Lighthouse closed the new board made it a priority to make sure ACLC would have somewhere to meet this year for their General Assembly meetings, Board Meetings and to have somewhere they could hold their free education classes.

They found Our Space/BAYC located in Hayward. This center "partners with vulnerable youth, empowering them to successfully transition to living independently as the most self-reliant, confident adults they can be." This space offers a safe space for LGBTQ youth ages 14-21 to explore their identities, socialize and build community.

Additionally, this space is a 501 (c)3 so just like the Lighthouse we as an organization can contin-

uously give back to them each year financially, in addition to having a space to call our home for meetings and education.



As always our meetings have never changed, they are on the second Thursday of every month at 7:30pm and we hope that new and old members come to check

out this new location the 2014-2015 Board has secured for us.

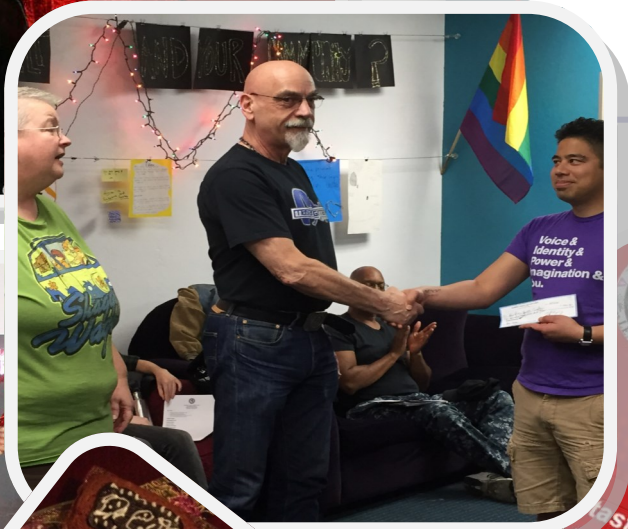
